

Bowler of the year awards

The following point system will be used to select the bowler of the year, senior bowler of the year and the Association All Star Teams. Although there are many ways that this process can be done, there has to be a set of guidelines which obtain the fairest way of selecting the bowlers. These guidelines have been set up and adopted by the Central Arkansas USBC Bowling association and will be used in the selection process.

Only scores bowled during the current Fall Season Leagues (sanctioned with the CAUSBCBA) and current year Association events will be considered for this award. Scores for this award will cut off March 31st of the current bowling season to allow for the calculation and ordering of the award.

Scores ***MUST*** be turned in by your league secretary prior to the April 22nd cutoff date to be considered. It is the bowler's and the league secretary's responsibility to ensure that the scores are turned in within 7 days of the date bowled.

Your feed back is welcomed at any of our association meetings.

ALL STAR TEAM

The following criteria will be used in selecting the Association All Star Team: Only scores bowled during the current Fall Season (sanctioned with the CAUSBCBA) and current year Association events will be considered for this award.

There will be 2 All Star Teams, Senior and Non Senior.

The senior all star team will be the five Senior Bowlers, must be 55 years of age by August 1st of current season, with the highest number of points using the point system below.

The Non Senior All Start Team will be the five non senior bowlers, must be under the age of 55 at the start of the current bowling season, with the highest number of points using the point system listed below.

Scores for this award will cut off April 14th of the current bowling season to allow for the calculation and ordering of the award.

Points—Points will count in any CABA league or CABA tournament from August 1- April 14

For the 1st year with enterprise closing add 1 spot per center that has less than 10. To qualify for this must have a min of 64 games in the league this would be 66% of a 32 week season. In addition to the above points 5 points will be awarded for each event a bowler enters in the Central Arkansas Annual Championship Tournament (maximum of 15 for the season) and 5 points for winning any event disregarding any special scratch events.
