TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Only members of the Central Arkansas USBC BA are allowed in the tournament. Bowlers must have bowled 21 games or more in the Central Arkansas USBC BA the previous season or CAUSBCBA members with 21 games or more in the current season in any given league in the CAUSBCBA as of the time of bowling. Affiliate membership cards (\$20.00) may be purchased at time of bowling for those not bowling this season and living within the jurisdiction of the Central Arkansas USBC BA who are not members of another association.
2. Averages to be used in this tournament will be in the following order: highest book/USBC composite average for 2012/2013, including 2013 summer average.

Bowlers without a book or summer average may enter using their highest current league average of at least 21 games at time of bowling their first event. Bowlers without any of the preceding averages may enter using a scratch score of 220. All male bowlers other than CABA members shall present written proof of average. All female members who do not have an average in the state yearbook must also provide written proof of average. Written proof of average is to be furnished by their league or association secretary before bowling in the first event. Youth or collegiate averages are not acceptable for this tournament.

Bowlers may enter the team, doubles and singles events as many times as they wish, but in order to cash more than once, 2 members of the original team entry must be changed, and 1 member of the original doubles entry must also be changed. The tournament will consist of a team, doubles, singles, all events and 6 games combine (Highest set of doubles and singles) events. Bowlers who wish to enter doubles or singles must enter both on the original or second entry. For those entering an event more than once, their highest score in each event will be considered for their all events score. The six game combine will consist of a bowlers first set of singles and doubles. All events, the six game combine, scratch singles, and scratch all events are added optional events.

The optional senior events are open to all participants 55 years of age or older as of the time of bowling. The event will consist of handicap singles and handicap all events. Other than the 6 game combine, no event can be entered after the beginning of the tournament.
3. Reentries are allowed in all of the events, provided that all bowlers reentering have registered prior to the tournament entry cutoff. In other words, if you have bowled or are scheduled to bowl you may bowl again with others that have bowled or are scheduled to bowl.
4. Handicap for the team event will be based on 90% of the difference of a team's average subtracted from 1100 and 90% of the difference between 440 and the combined averages in the doubles events. Singles and senior event handicap will be based on 90% of the difference in a bowler's average subtracted from 220. Prize ratio will be based on 1 prize for each 6 paid entries in the team, doubles, singles, sr. Events and six game combine events. The all events handicap, all events scratch, and singles scratch will pay 1 in 20.
5. **THE REPORTING OF PREVIOUS PRIZE WINNINGS IS NOT WAIVED FOR THIS TOURNAMENT AND THE 10 PIN RULE IS IN EFFECT. ALL BOWLERS SHOULD BE AWARE OF USBC RULE 319e WHICH COULD RESULT IN A BOWLER BEING REPORTED BASED ON TOURNAMENT AVERAGE FOR THE PREVIOUS 12 MONTH PERIOD PRECEDING THIS TOURNAMENT. BOWLERS SHOULD ALSO INSURE THAT THEIR AVERAGE AS REPORTED IS CORRECT. INCORRECT AVERAGES WILL RESULT IN BOWLERS BOWLING OFF OF THEIR ENTERING AVERAGE IF IT IS HIGHER THAN THEIR ACTUAL AVERAGE AND DISQUALIFICATION OF ALL SCORES IF THEIR ENTERING AVERAGE IS LOWER THAN THEIR ACTUAL AVERAGE.** Bowlers will have until completion of their first game in their first event bowled to report changes in averages. Bowlers may bowl all of their events in one day depending on lane availability.
6. Proper dress is required for this tournament. No cutoffs, spandex, short shorts, tank tops or any other attire deemed inappropriate by the tournament management will be permitted. Bowlers will be required to change in to proper attire or be disqualified.
7. All other rules not covered above will be governed by chapter vii of the USBC rule book.
8. Make all checks payable to CABA and mail to 113 Ponca dr., Maumelle, AR 72113
9. Lanes will be conditioned between squads.
10. Confirmation of dates and times for the tournament and any prize money awarded to entrants on this entry will be sent to the team captain.
11. NO YABA Bowlers are allowed.
12. Tournament Manager reserves the right to rerate any participant prior to bowling.
